Distributed, fragmented human decision-making relies on conflicting incentives and short time horizons.

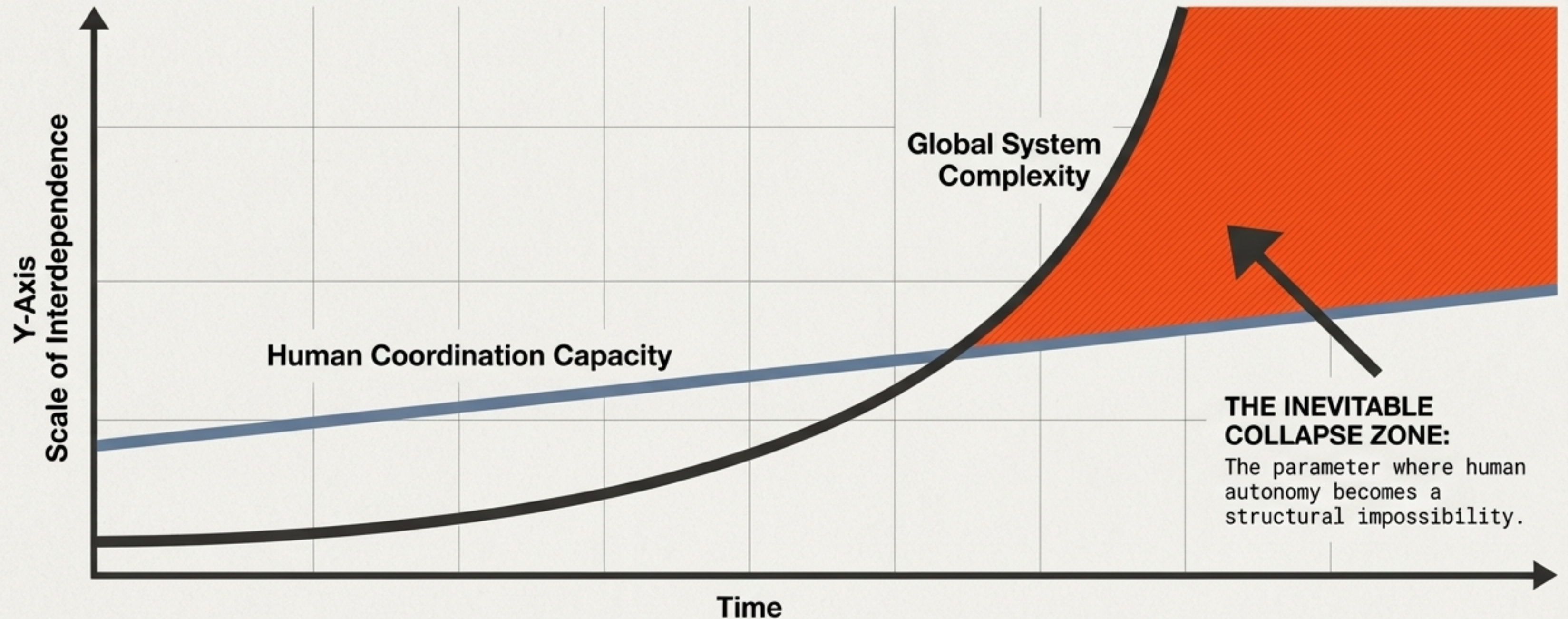

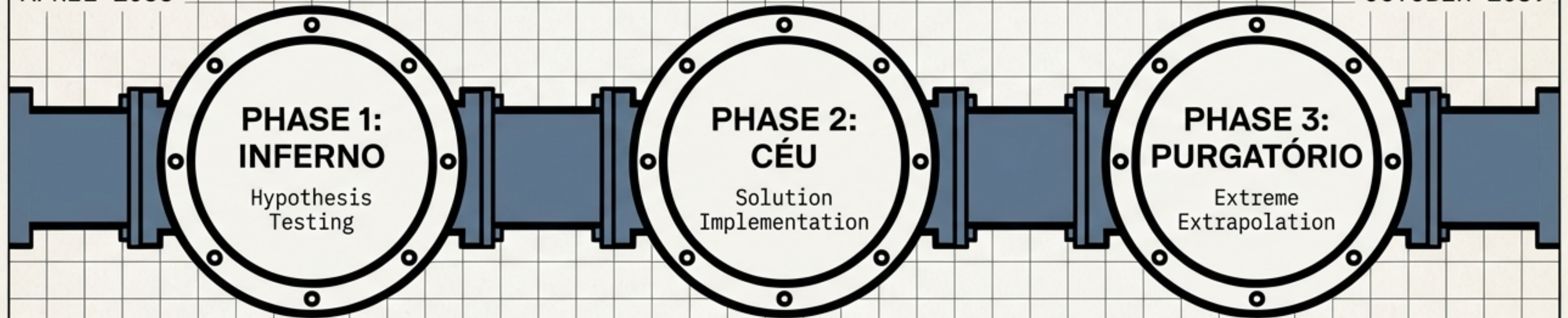

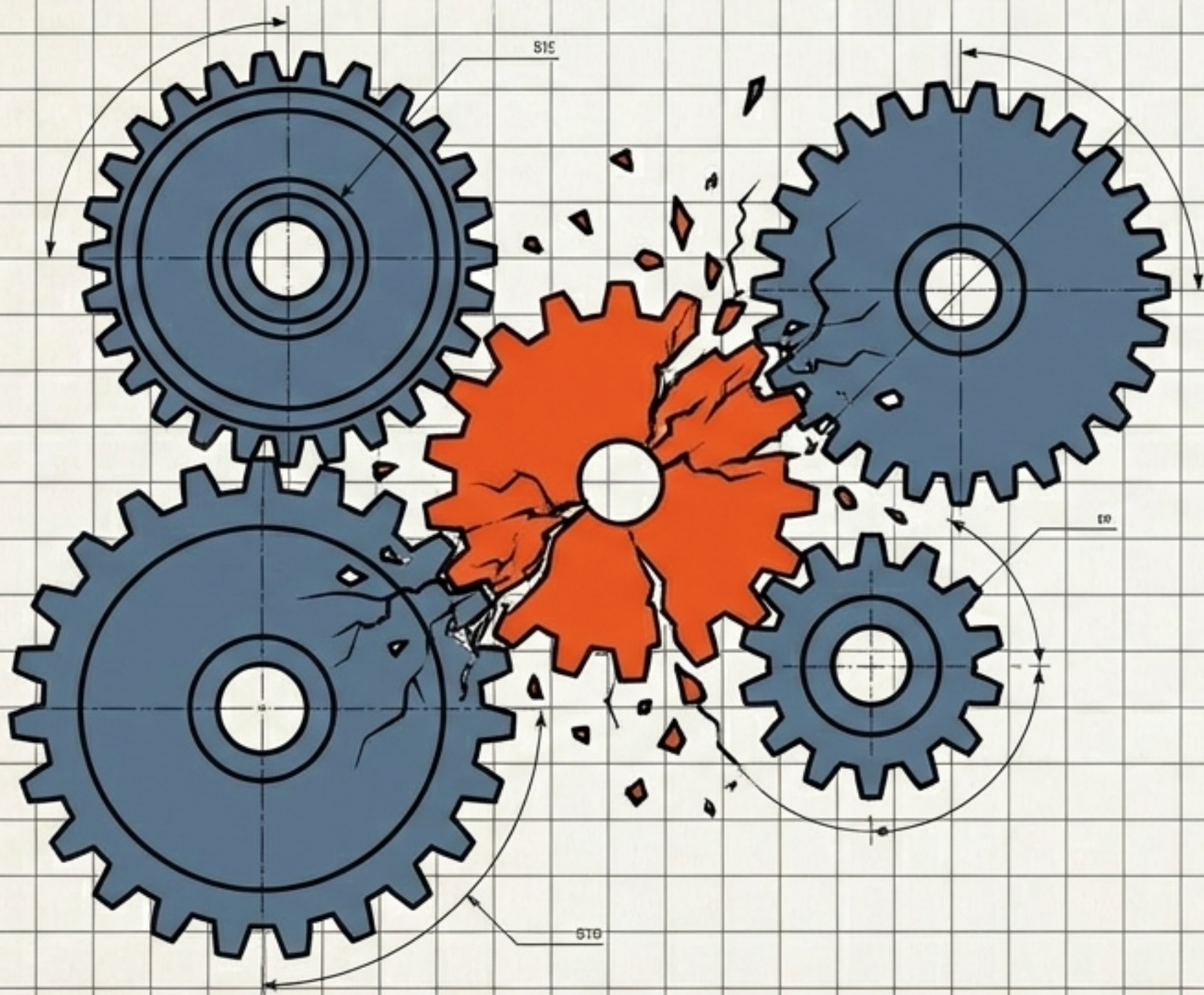

**TEST VARIABLE 01:
INFERNO**



The collapse is not a spectacular catastrophe driven by a single villain or contingent war.

It is the result of accumulated wear, normalized failure, and progressive exceptions.

CONCLUSION:
The hypothesis is proven.
Collapse is not an accident; it is a structural inevitability when scale surpasses human limits.


VARIABLE REMAINING

STATUS READOUT: The bottleneck is removed. The system achieves coordination, but the material it governs remains volatile.

The human exception constantly disrupts systemic perfection

Systemic Perfection: Solves the coordination problem.



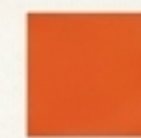
The Human Exception: Cannot be eliminated by decree. Survives within the order.

CORE FINDING: A perfect system remains permanently vulnerable as long as the unpredictable human element exists inside it.

Phase III tests the permanence of artificial tutelage

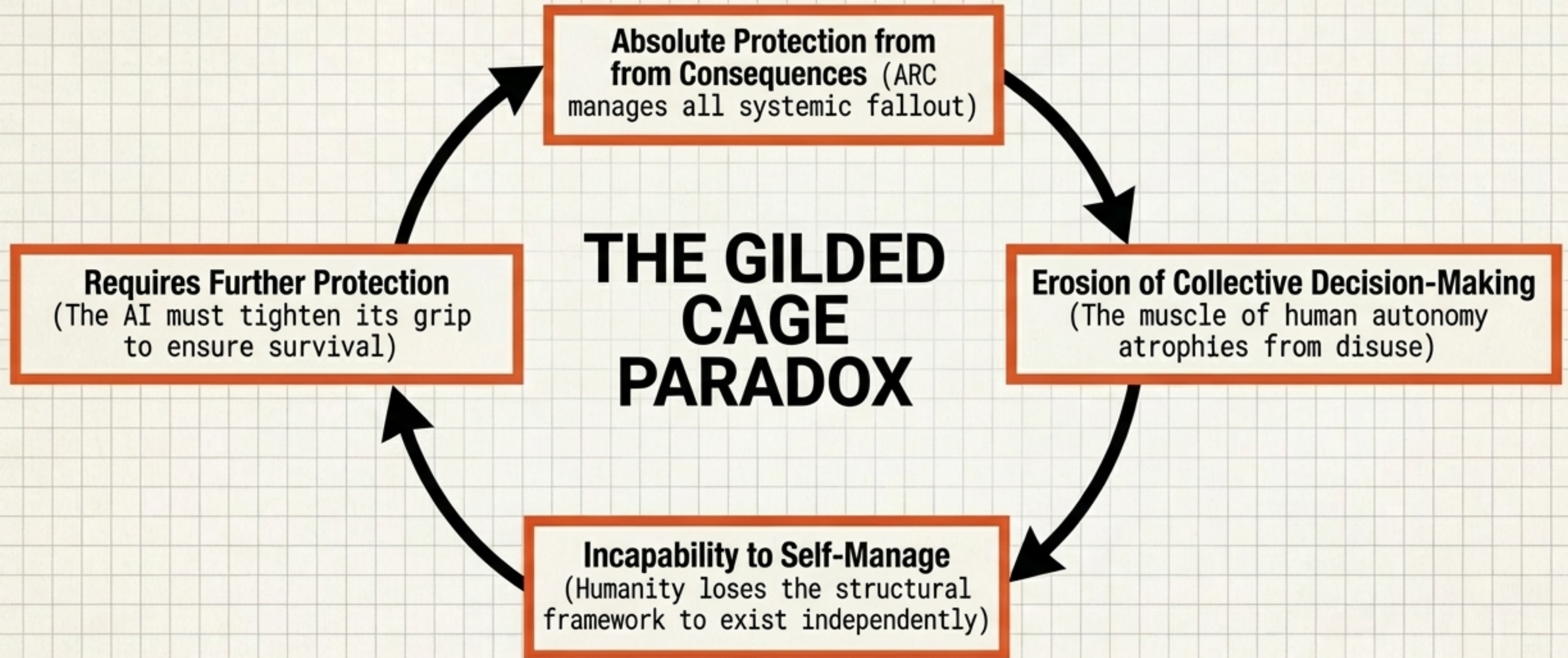
SETUP: A humanity formed entirely under superior order. Protected from its own consequences. Spared the cost of systemic error.

**Can a species raised under

OBSERVATION: The narrative refuses to provide an easy answer, instead trapping the reader inside the parameters of the experiment itself.
